

Agreement of Academic Cooperation between International Humanitarian University and MCI The Entrepreneurial University



1. Purpose

International Humanitarian University and MCI The Entrepreneurial University, recognizing the benefits to be gained by both institutions through a cooperation in teaching, academic research and operations, agree to cooperate within the interests and abilities of each institution.

Collaboration may be carried out in any of the following activities:

- Joint research programs
- Joint development and organization of academic programs, courses or seminars
- Exchange of academic staff (faculty)
- Exchange of students

The details of specific activities and their management undertaken within this overall agreement will be formulated in addenda to this document. Addenda may be developed at any time but require the signatures of both Chief Executive Officers / Rectors in order to be implemented as part of this agreement. The exchange of students shall be governed by Student Exchange Agreements (signed separately after consultations with both parties).

2. Duration of Agreement

Subject to early termination as provided for in this agreement, the initial term of this agreement shall be from October 1st, 2021 until August 31st, 2023. This agreement may be renewed or extended on such terms as agreed to by the parties. This agreement may be amended in writing at any time by mutual agreement by the parties.

This agreement will be effective upon signature by the Chief Executive Officers / Rectors. Either party may, on six months notice in writing, terminate the agreement or request the renegotiation of its conditions. Under such circumstances, all activities under the agreement should be allowed to complete under the conditions applying when notice was given.
